


3 year Ford warranty on a used car?

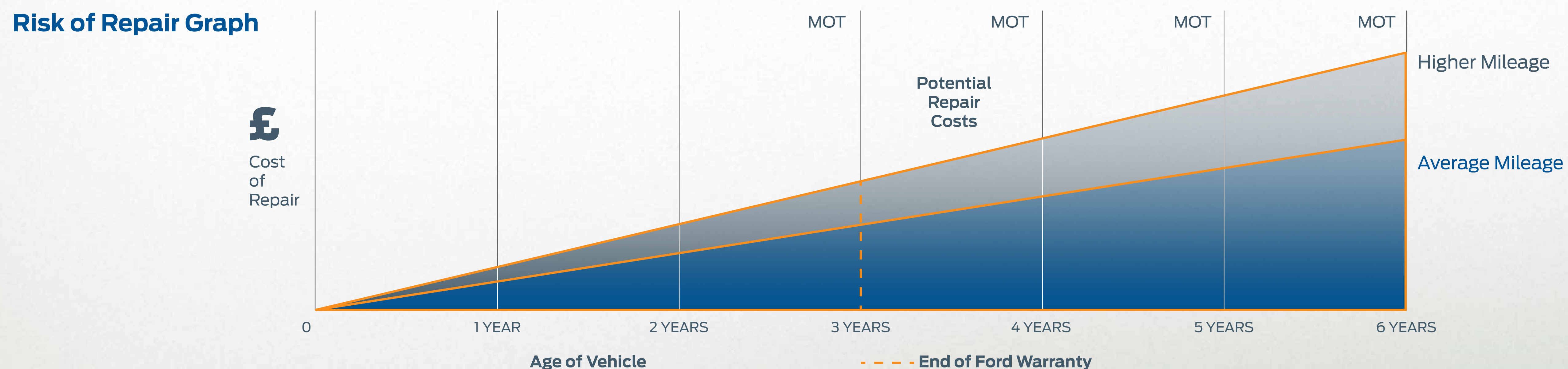
A new car has a 3 year warranty. Why shouldn't your used car have a 3 year warranty? The listing below details some of the features and systems covered by Ford Protect Gold.
